- 1. Disconnect wiring connector from light
- 2. Remove 3 screws in plates that connect center and corner light
- 3. Remove 4 mounting bolts and remove light
- 4. Install new Hy-Cap light into grille and replace 4 mount bolts (New bolts have been supplied with new lights)
- 5. Replace 3 screws into connecting plate (New bolts have been supplied with new lights)
- 6. Once light is positioned properly, secure lights by tightening all hardware
- 7. Attach electrical connectors
- 8. Repeat steps 1-7 for both lights

- 1. Disconnect wiring connectors from light
- 2. There is a plate joining the lights together. Remove 3 screws from the plate to release light
- 3. Remove 4 mounting bolts that hold light in place and remove light from grille
- 4. Install new Hy-Cap light into grille and replace 4 mount bolts (New bolts have been supplied with new lights)
- 5. Replace 3 screws into connecting plate (New bolts have been supplied with new lights)
- 6. Once light is positioned properly, secure lights by tightening all hardware
- 7. Attach blue electrical connector to power light
- 8. Replace Plastic Panel
- 9. The original light contained a side light that will no longer be needed (The connection can be covered or sealed with electrical tape or wire nut)
- 10. Repeat steps 1-7 for both lights
